This year also features our Student Technician Skills Competition, TMC FutureTech 2026, which will take place in parallel with the professional competition. All meeting attendees are welcome to observe the competitions.

The Council is also offering the **TEC Technician Training Fair**, which takes place following the competition written test on Monday, Sept. 21.
